

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR ENTERING OF EXHIBITS

- Exhibits must be entered on Thursday, September 22, 2016 between 3:00 p.m. and 7:00 p.m. at Chilhowie Old High School. The only exception is the entry of flower show exhibits which may be entered between 8:00 and 9:00 a.m. on Friday, September 23, 2016.
- Although every precaution will be taken to protect exhibits from damage or loss the Apple Festival will not be financially liable in case of such an event.
- Exhibits may not be removed before 4:00 p.m. on Sunday, September 25, 2016. No entry can be removed without the ticket stub provided upon submission of exhibit.
- First, Second and Third place ribbons will be awarded in all divisions. All ribbons will be given at the judge's discretion. The judge will decide the placing position if there is only one entry in a class. No prize money will be given out this year. Ribbons will be given more generously in each category.
- All exhibits must be made, canned, or grown by the exhibitor since last Apple Festival and must be entered in the exhibitor's name. However, corn exhibits may be from last year's crop.
- A Best in Show Rosette will be awarded in the Sewing, Craft, Baked Goods, Canned Foods, Agriculture Products, High School Art, Adult Art, Horticulture, Flower Show, High School Photography and Adult Photography. This award will be presented to the best of all Blue Ribbon winners in each division.
- The Apple Rosette will be awarded to the entry in each of the above divisions which best depicts apples.
- Youth exhibits will be judged separately from the adults.
- The exhibitor may enter only one exhibit in any class with the exception of art and photography. Two exhibits be may entered in each of the classes in the Art Show and a total of 12 exhibits may be entered in the Photography Show with a maximum of 2 in each class. All artwork is limited to one showing per piece in a lifetime.
