HONORING VIRGINIA'S BEAUTIES A Tribute to Virginia Apples

SECTION I. TRI-COLOR

All fresh materials

- Class 1. **GALA – widely grown, sweet variety**
Inspired by the abundance and beauty of Virginia apples.

SECTION II. DESIGNER'S CHOICE

Fresh and/or dried materials. Accessories are allowed, but are **limited** to the container, the backdrop and **one** additional item.

- Class 2. **FUJI – modern apple, crisp and sweet**
An Asian-inspired arrangement.
- Class 3. **GRANNY SMITH – most recognized of all**
An **all-green** arrangement reminiscent of times past.

SECTION III. EXHIBITION TABLE ARRANGEMENT

All fresh materials and dinnerware artistically arranged with the plant material placed where needed to carry the rhythm, repeated colors and overall degree of formality. Decorative unit should be in pleasing proportion to the space allotted.

- Class 4. **CAMEO – sweet, firm, crisp, and aromatic**
Items limited to five – cup/saucer; and dinner plate/salad plate each count as one item; tablecloth placemat; napkin, dishes, beverage service, or serving pieces are allowed.

SECTION IV. CHILDREN'S EXHIBIT

Fresh and/or dried materials - Technology Entry.

- Class 5. **EMPIRE – red, juicy, firm, crunchy, and sweet**
This category is limited to school-aged children. Arrangement should include one technology-related item, such as the container; an item which is part of the arrangement; or as an accessory.
