

DIVISION II – FLOWER DESIGN

FLAVORS OF FALL

SECTION I TRI-COLOR

Class 1. ***Fall in Love***

Mass arrangement using all fresh materials in keeping with the theme. No accessories, or artificial, treated or dyed materials may be used.

SECTION II DESIGNER'S CHOICE

Class 2. ***Pumpkin Spice***

Dried and/or fresh materials may be used, and accessories in keeping with the theme are allowed. These may include the container, or elements added to the arrangement to reflect the theme. The use of pumpkins as a container or accessory is encouraged.

SECTION III DOOR DECORATIONS

Class 3. ***Warm and Welcome***

Door decorations including wreaths and swags using fresh and/or dried materials. ABSOLUTELY NO ARTIFICIAL FLOWERS, GREENERY, WREATHS, ETC WILL BE ALLOWED. Grapevine, straw, Styrofoam, or wire forms allowed. Use of ribbon and/or bows allowed. Be mindful of the display – easel, backboard, window frame, etc.

SECTION IV CHILDREN'S EXHIBITS

Class 4. ***Fall Festival***

Children may use fresh and/or dried materials to create an arrangement depicting the celebration of fall. Accessories are permitted and the use of apples in the arrangement is encouraged.

The flower show is open to anyone interested in entering an exhibit, and members of the public are encouraged to participate. You do not have to be a member of the Chilhowie Garden Club. Exhibitors may only enter one arrangement in each class. In all arrangements, no artificial flowers or plants may be used. Fresh and dried materials cannot be treated or dyed, but must remain natural.

NOTE that the Apple Award will be given in any class which allows the use of apples in the arrangement.
